Easter 2022: Empty (Luke 24:1-12) (Philipians 2:5-8)

I. The Resurrection

-the burial of Christ proves that Jesus really did die on the Cross

-Jesus was physically dead..He then arose and appeared before His followers

-Jesus appearing before His disciples & followers proved that He was alive

-Jesus did what He said that He would do and the Resurrection gives <u>validity</u> to who Jesus claimed to be 1 Corinthians 15:17-19 NLT

II. Emptiness

-Empty= containing **<u>nothing</u>**, not **<u>filled</u>**, not <u>**occupied**</u>

-our lives are often filled with <u>emptiness</u> <u>Relationally</u>, emotionally/mentally, <u>physically</u>, financially, and <u>spiritually</u>

-we find ourselves: not filled...not occupied..not satisfied

-Life simply isn't filling

-Henry David Thoreau: we live 'lives of quiet desperation'

III. Christ & Emptiness

we were never created to live <u>'empty'</u>lives

Christ **<u>emptied</u>** Himself and that led to the Cross and then the tomb Philippians 2:5-8 (ESV)

Christ knows what <u>emptiness</u> feels like (Matthew 27:46)

-If no Resurrection, then our faith would be <u>vain &</u> <u>worthless (empty)</u> 1 Corinthians 5:14 (ESV)

Christ left the tomb empty so that we do not have to live 'empty'

We can be **<u>filled</u>** with Christ which is an **<u>inwardly</u>** strengthening Philippians 4:12-13

Christ fills us, occupies us, & we can live life satisfied in Him

The only thing that should remain empty is the tomb
