Life Group Questions

- 1) How might you practice being a non-judgemental presence in our world?
- 2) What are the reasons that <u>you</u> might judge someone?
- 3) From the previous question; What are some reasons others could judge you?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 4) In 1 Cor. 2:15-16 Paul says the Spirit of God in you gives you the ability to discern what's going on in the world.
 - a) How can discernment become condemnation?
 - b) Discuss what we can do to be sure that doesn't happen to us?
- 1. Instead of carrying a gavel, Jesus is telling us to bring a flashlight (don't judge, shine a light, help restore others).
 - a. Are there things we can do as a faith family that will help us follow Jesus' command?
 - b. What 'logs' might you have to remove before you can help your brother/sister?
