Seven Letters To Seven Churches: What To Do About Spiritual Attacks (James 4:6-8)

I. Context

The believers in the churches of Pergamum & Thyatira were under severe <u>spiritual</u> attacks by the devil

We see 'Jezebel' attacking in the Old Testament and the New Testament

II. Spiritual Attacks

Oppression is different than possession

Christians believers cannot be <u>possessed</u> by a demon

We are <u>indwelt</u> by the Holy Spirit (*Romans 8:9-11, I Cor. 3:16, 6:19, 1 John 4:4*)

Christian believers can be oppressed or influenced by a demon

III. When does the devil spiritually attack believers?

The devil is <u>sneaky</u> & strategically waits for the most <u>opportune</u> time 1 Peter 5:8

IV. How does the devil spiritually attack believers?

1 Kings 19:1-18, Revelation 2:14,20

1:<u>fear</u> 2:<u>depression</u> 3:<u>fatigue</u> 4:<u>insecurity</u> 5:<u>offense</u> 6:negative <u>thoughts</u> 7:lack of spiritual <u>passion/ferver</u> 8:quitting your <u>assignment</u> 9:<u>idolatry</u> 10: <u>temptation/addiction(immorality)</u>

V. What do I do when I am under a spiritual attack?

James 4:6:8

Submit to God

...draw near to Him

....humble yourself

....repent

Resist the devil (1 Peter 5:9)

...hold fast

= the devil has to flee
