Worship: Read Psalms 100 . . . Talk about the goodness of God and what it looks like to follow Him

Read: Jeremiah 9:23-24

Question: Why do we tend to boast in who we are and what we have?

Question: What are we called to boast in?

Question: What does it say about God that He blesses through kindness, justice, and righteousness? What should it say about His followers?

Read: Jeremiah 22:15-16

Question: So what does it say here about the relationship between helping the needy and being in a love relationship with God?

Question: Can you think of other passages where the Bible talks about this?

Question: Why is it that so much of the time we are hesitant to serve?

Question: Tell us about your experience in serving others on Sunday? (allow each person to share)

Question: How can serving the city be a bridge to salvation?

Question: How can salvation be a bridge to serving the city?

Read: Joshua 24:14-16

Question: Are there other gods that you are putting before serving God?

Question: Frankly speaking, are you really serious about serving the Lord? If so, how do you show it?

Reflect on “Serving Sunday” and what we did and think about how we can give ourselves away further.
