<p>Objective: That each of us would seek to humble ourselves before God this week.</p>

Icebreaker: What's one 'New Years Resolution' (spoken or unspoken) that you've already broken?

Worship: Soak in Psalm 71:1-4 – Talk about what God is saying to you?

Read: Matthew 21:28-32

Question: What is Jesus teaching His followers about the Kingdom here? [many different things leaders . . .]

Question: What is the real difference in the two sons? Which story is more like yours? Explain?

Question: What does verse 31 say about the timing of the Kingdom of God? [It is a PRESENT reality . . . 'are entering' . . . with a future promise]

Read: Matthew 21:42-44

Question: How do these verses summarize the parable we read above?

Question: What is the difference between 'falling on the stone' and being 'crushed by the stone'? [Falling is a voluntary act of surrender; being crushed is an involuntary act of judgment] What practically does it look like to fall on the stone?

Question: What is the awesome result of a life humbled before God? [v. 43]

Question: Does it take more passion, courage, vision to 'fall on the stone' or be 'crushed by the stone'? Why?

Pray: Pray for humility before God for one another. "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways; then I will hear from heaven and forgive their sin and heal their land." (2 Chron 7:14)
