Objective: That every Creeker would understand the gravity and purpose of the statement:
Jesus is Lord!

Icebreaker: What is something you're holding on to that you would have a difficult time giving up for your faith? [Be honest! 😊]

Worship: Read the Colossians passage below out loud and have everyone ask everyone before hand to just grab onto something as you read. Then let everyone have 3-4 minutes to reflect on what they've heard. Finish by giving everyone an opportunity to pray.

Read: Deuteronomy 6:4-5

Question: What did you learn about these verses (that the Jews call the Shema) on Sunday?

Question: This was the Hebrews foundational declaration of who God was. What is the significance of their declaration that 'The Lord is one'?

Question: What does it mean to love God with ALL your heart, soul and strength?

Read: Colossians 1:15-20

Question: How many different things do these verses tell us about Jesus? In your opinion what's the most important Truth these verses reveal about Jesus?

Questions: What kind of misconceptions about Jesus do you think that Paul was trying to overcome?

Question: What do these verses tell us about living in the Kingdom of God?

Pray: Pray that God will reveal in each of our lives where other 'idols' are sitting on throne and that we will destroy them.
