Worship: Read Psalm 41:1-3. Pray.....

Read: Isaiah 1:17

Question: How do you respond to these statements?

- 1) “Justice is finding out what belongs to whom and returning it to them.”
- 2) “Justice is the act of instituting love for those people you don’t know.”

Question: How would you define justice?

Read: Luke 4:1, 14, & 18

Question: What is the common element in each of these verses?

Question: What does this tell us about the source of Jesus’ power?

Read: Luke 4: 16, 21-22

Question: What is significant about the time, place, and posture for Jesus’ discourse from Isaiah?

Question: What expectations stirred in the people as a result of Jesus’ claim?

Read: Luke 4: 18-19

Question: What is Jesus’ five-fold mission?

Question: How does He fulfill it literally? Spiritually? Then? Now?

Think about this statement by David J. Bosch:

“Mission is not primarily an activity of the church, but an attribute of God.”

Pray: Pray for anything that gets discussed above. You may want to break up into small groups of 2 or 3.
