Life Group Questions

- 1) Pastor Terry asked the question “Whom do you trust?” This past year may have shaken your faith in some of the ‘bigs’ he mentioned. Discuss how the events of the last year have impacted your ‘faith’ in others.
- 2) One way to ensure that the media you are consuming is Biblically accurate is to talk to others about it (Proverbs 11:14). Share with your Life Group any podcasts or websites you go to for solid Biblical teachings and articles.
- 3) We read John 11:35 “Jesus wept.” As a group, look it up and discuss why Jesus did weep and what it shows us concerning Him.

- 4) James 2:26 speaks to faith without works is dead. If faith requires ‘head and heart’ to be genuine, how do you know that your faith is more than just an ‘intellectual decision’?
- 5) Our lesson this week ended with the words, “Do not be deceived.” Read 1 John 4:1-3. We have the answer to making sure we are not deceived. This week as you read, study and pray, ask God for the wisdom to see the truth and stay close to it. Be wise in the spirit.
